

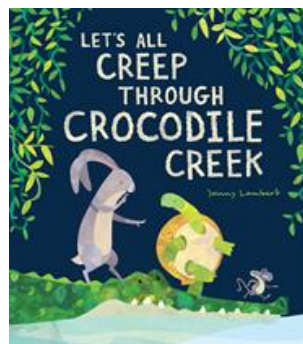


Term: Spring 1

Communication and Language

Your child will learn to take turns in back and forth conversation. They will orally retell an event or story using complete sentences. They will learn to respond to open questions and respond using complete sentences.

Literacy

Your child will take part in a daily phonics session and a daily story session. They will have lots of opportunities for mark making and writing. They will take part in 'Drawing Club' where they will listen to a well-known story and then be creative in their descriptive drawings.

Our Literacy focus book will be 'Let's All Creep Through Crocodile Creek'.

We will use 'Poetry Basket' daily to learn new rhymes and poems.



Personal, Social and Emotional

Self-regulation – talking to others about how we are feeling and develop strategies for coping with feelings

Managing Self – understanding the need to have rules, making healthy food choices and looking after our teeth

Building relationships – talking about being a good friend, what is kind and unkind. Build on our friendships

Mastering Number



Maths

We use NCETM Mastering Number. This half term you child will continue to develop their subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers within and beyond 5. They will begin to identify when two sets are equal or unequal and connect two equal groups to doubles. They will begin to connect quantities to numerals.

Physical Development

Gross motor skills – your child will have lots of opportunity to develop their strength, balance, coordination and agility and learn how to move safely in a space.

Fine motor skills – activities to promote using a tripod grip when using mark making tools including dough disco.

Understanding the World

Your child will talk about the relationship they have to members of their own family. They will talk about their own family and how it is unique, they will look at families in other countries.

They will explore the natural environment around us and seasonal changes. We will take part in the RSPB Bird School's Birdwatch.

They will celebrate Chinese New Year and Valentine's Day.

We will learn to say hello in a different language each week



Expressive Art and Design

Your child will be exploring colour, texture and different ways to mark make. They will be drawing, painting and making self-portraits.

Exploring musical instruments; the sounds they make and how they can be changed.



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Reading

As your child learns letters in their phonics sessions, they will be given reading books or Ditty Sheets.

Please read with your child every evening. Record and sign what has been read in your child's reading diary.

They will bring home a 'Reading for Pleasure' book for you to share at home.



Christian Values

Dojo
